CREATING A WINTAC USER ACCOUNT

A WINTAC user account is required to access all trainings (live, recorded, and self-paced).

- 1. <u>Go to the WINTAC website</u>.
- 2. Click Login on the top menu.
- 3. Click Create new account.
- 4. Fill out the form. All fields are required.
- 5. Click the **I'm not a robot** check box in the CAPTCHA section.
- 6. Click Create new account. An email will be sent to the email address you entered above.
- 7. Go to your email application and open the email from <u>admin@wintac.org</u>
 - a. If you cannot find the email in your Inbox, please check your Spam/Junk folder.
 - b. If you cannot find it in neither your Inbox nor the Spam/Junk folder, please contact wintacit@wintac.org for further assistance.
- Click the link in the email. This will direct you to a page for you to set your password.
 If clicking the link does not automatically send you to the web page, copy the URL in the email and paste it in the address bar of your browser window.
- 9. Click the **Log in** button.

- 10. Type in your password in both Password and Confirm password boxes.
 - a. You can also upload a profile picture and/or set your time zone on this screen.
- 11. Scroll down and click the Save button.
- 12. A notification will appear at the top of the page in a green box: "The changes have been saved." This completes the process for creating a new account.

ENROLLING IN WINTAC TRAINING

Please note: As of 08/01/2017, the WINTAC user account is the only account required to enroll in and access all trainings (live, recorded, and self-paced). Users will no longer need to register with Adobe Connect to attend live training sessions.

- 1. Log in to the WINTAC website:
- 2. Click Training on the top menu and select either Upcoming Online Live Training or Recorded Training.
- 3. Locate the training you want to enroll in and click Enter the training site on the TMS: TID#######.
 - a. NOTE: The enrollment link will not appear if the training is not yet open for enrollment.
 - b. To receive email notifications when WINTAC online live trainings become open for enrollment, sign up for our distribution list.
- 4. Once you click the link, you will automatically be enrolled in the training.
- 5. The link will take you to the training site, where you will find a direct link to the training session, as well as additional training access information and materials.

- 2. To easily access your enrolled training(s) at a later time, return to the WINTAC website and log in.
 - a. If you are already logged in, click My account on the top menu.
- 3. Locate the **My Training** section on the left-side panel and click the title of the training you would like to access.

REQUESTING A NEW PASSWORD

If you forget your password, you will need to request a new password.

- 1. <u>Go to the WINTAC website</u>.
- 2. Click the Login link.
- 3. Click Request new password.

4. Type in your username **OR** your email address.

NOTE: Please make sure to provide the email address that is linked to your WINTAC account.

- 5. Click the E-mail new password button.
- 6. Go to your email application and check for the email from WINTAC.

NOTE: The email subject starts with "Replacement login information for..."

- 7. Click the link in the email. Your browser window will show the Reset password page.
- 8. Click the **Log in** button.
- 9. Type in a new password in both **Password** and **Confirm password** text boxes.
- 10. Scroll down and click the **Save** button.
